### Education

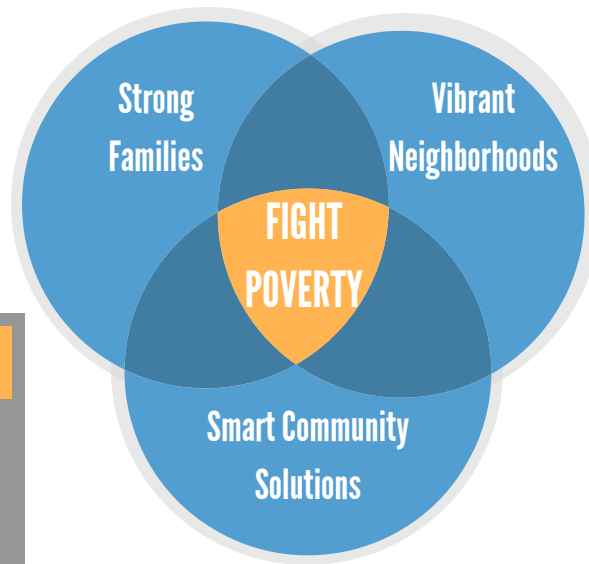
**Success By 6:** Early childhood education support and programs.
