

What does it cost to afford the basics in our community?





Housing: Below average size and cost with utilities (1- bedroom apartment for head of household with 1-child)

2018 Federal Poverty Guidelines: \$25,100

Median Household Income: \$43,706



Childcare: Cheapest legal home-based childcare



Food: No eating out with careful purchasing and preparation



Transportation: Gas, insurance and basic repairs with no lease or car payments



Healthcare: Basic out-of-pocket costs with no insurance premiums included



Taxes: Income taxes, credits, Social Security, and Medicare



Miscellaneous 10% of the total for cost overruns and other essentials (e.g. phone, higher utilities cost, medical costs, fewer grocery sales)
